As part of the authentic assessment experience of the We the People program, the Center for Civic Education has released their State Hearing Questions for the academic year 2021-2022. All teachers have access to utilize these questions in assessing their student's understanding of the fundamental principles of our government. You may use one or all questions for your students in any way that you believe would best assess the student's understanding and engagement in the material.

A panel of experts gathers each week to discuss ideas and resources related to the 2021-22 WTP State hearing questions. The sessions are recorded and posted on a You Tube channel called "The Four B's." The Four B's consist of Mike Williams, Chris Cavanaugh, David Richmond, and Tim Moore each having an extensive background in the WTP programs and competitions.

Many teachers over the past year have found these recorded discussions to be helpful to their students. The Four B's do not answer the hearing questions so much as discuss and dissect the ideas contained within the questions. Each session is approximately an hour in length, includes time stamps, and provides links to additional resources.
